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Westmont Northside Village Tour April 27, 2014

- The Manning School alley between Linden and Cass was examined.
- Linden/Norfolk (flooding area)
- 30 North Lincoln
- Drove the alley between Cass/Lincoln.
- Hudson/Washington Street Alley from Naperville to Irving.
- West Burlington Street was driven to Cumnor
- Roslyn Road, Cumnor, Morning Glory Circle and Birch Point Condos were next.
- Park Street (flooding area), Chicago Avenue, Washington Street, P.D. Department Building (retention basin), Northeast Acres,
- Traube/Warwick flooding area, Blackhawk Drive/Standard Market, Westmont Drive/Plaza Drive.
- A brief stop at Ty Warner Park
- North Cass to Oak Brook Hills, Residence of Oak Brook Hills, Royal Hills Condos, Indian Trails detention, 41st Street, Liberty Park Well, Washington Street Well.

- Pasquinelli Drive, Gateway Signs, Water Tower along Pasquinelli Drive Corridor possibilities, Oakwood Drive, Citadel, Warwick

The tour concluded.

Trustee Senicka made a motion to adjourn. Trustee Barker seconded the motion. The vote was all ayes. The motion passed.
