7. **Unfinished Business**

a. **Review Of Class 16 Liquor License**

Board to discuss and perform a periodic review of the practice of allowing a customer to bring their own bottle of alcohol (BYOB) into a liquor licensed premises.

Background Of Subject Matter	At it's inception, the board requested a periodic review of BYOB liquor licenses issued within the village. Bakersfield Restaurant recently requested and was subsequently granted the first Class 16 BYOB license by the Liquor Commissioner.
Additional Background	There have been no violations of the license since it was issued on June 11, 2012.
Recomendation	Continue the periodic review of Class 16 licenses

8. **New Business**

a. **640 Pasquinelli Drive- Fifth Third Bank-Zoning Code Variance**

Board to consider an ordinance granting a Zoning Code Variance request from Fifth Third Bank to increase the number of allowable signs.

Background Of Subject Matter	The applicant is requesting to revise existing wall and ground signs in accordance with the new Fifth Third branding, and is requesting a variance to allow a second sign on the lot, where one is allowed by Code.
Additional Background	Previously, the building had three wall signs and one ground sign, so this would be a reduction from four to two total signs on the lot. The total area requested for both signs meets signage requirements.
Recomendation	Planning and Zoning Commission recommended unanimous approval of a motion to allow a Zoning Code Variance Request to increase the number of allowable signs.

b. **200 East Ogden Avenue-Mercedes Benz Of Westmont-Variance And Site/Landscaping Plan Approval Requests**

Board to consider an ordinance granting approval of the following requests from Mercedes Benz:

- Zoning Code Variance to reduce the setbacks for a landlocked lot to 6' in the B-2 District.
- Site and landscaping plan approval for a parking lot addition.

Background Of Subject Matter	In 2006 the Village Board granted approval of a license agreement with Mercedes Benz in order to facilitate a parking lot expansion for the dealership. This expansion includes Village owned property around a well site.
Additional Background	At this time, the petitioner is ready to complete the work and received a favorable recommendation for the site and landscaping plan and setback variance at the June 13, 2012 Planning and Zoning Committee meeting.
Recomendation	The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended unanimous approval of the variance and site/landscaping plan with the following commentary: The Commission suggested that Public Works communicate with the dealership prior to exercising the well.

c. **United Meters, Inc.-Professional Services Agreement**

Board to consider an ordinance approving an agreement with United Meters, Inc. to perform certain water meter replacement services on behalf of the Village.

Background Of Subject Matter	The ongoing water meter replacement program includes the removal and replacement of 2600 residential water meters. This exceeds the capacity of in-house staff. This contract will permit the contractor to replace all meters before Winter.
Additional Background	The agreement is based on unit prices for each size meter installation. Based on these unit prices, the total amount of project is estimated at \$260,000. This work is budgeted in the current fiscal year.
Recomendation	The Public Works Committee and Staff recommend approval of said agreement.

Background Of Subject Matter	In 2007, the Village conducted a partial Special Census to determine the Village's population. According to the 1970 Illinois Constitution, a community whose population is 25,000 or more is automatically granted Home Rule status.
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<i>Additional Background</i>	The partial Special Census placed the Village's population at 26,211 and, in November 2007, the Village Board adopted Ordinance No. 07-178 declaring the Village a Home Rule community.
