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The Chicago Prostate Center was established in 1997. The current location is a state of the art facility which was built in 2006. The procedure they use is the “seed” procedure. This is the only facility where this particular procedure is done. It is an outpatient procedure, which takes approximately 1 hour, the patient is usually there for approximately 3 hours. This procedure does not require 8 weeks of chemotherapy as does other treatments.

Dr. Brian Moran is the head physician and has performed thousands of procedures. He has also proctored several physicians on this procedure. People from all over the world are treated at this facility. Approximately 70% of their referrals are by word of mouth.
